OUR HISTORY AND OUR MISSION

Founded in 2018 by passionate volunteers determined to foster academic and life success, the Teens Rise Foundation is dedicated to pursuing education equity and providing underserved youth with academic opportunities.

We address inequalities in resources and in opportunities that impact college readiness by supporting youth nationally in three areas of their academic and professional journeys: (1) Teens Getting Ready for College, (2) Teens Going to College, (3) Teens Succeeding in College and Beyond.



Serves, Scholars, y Salud

Teens Rise Foundation's signature program—Serves, Scholars, y Salud—promotes educational opportunity, physical wellness, and mental health for students in direct partnership with school districts.

SERVES

Entry-level tennis programs offered through physical education classes and after school programs build personal integrity; develop leadership, confidence, and self-esteem; and nurture a competitive spirit in a friendly environment.

SCHOLARS

Opportunities for academic enrichment in class and after school build foundational English and Math skills, prepare students for college entrance exams and college applications, and increase students' chances for success in college and beyond.

SALUD

Students receive resources to nurture their personal, mental, and emotional health. Offered programs support students to gain knowledge and to develop strategies that maintain and enhance well-being.
